# Grasses



## Idaho Fescue

*4ci cone plug*                      \$2.00

Perennial Bunchgrass, 30 to 90 cm tall

Low to subalpine elevations in grasslands on north facing slopes



## Indian Ricegrass

*4ci cone plug*                      \$2.00


Perennial Bunchgrass, 20 to 75 cm tall

Tightly rolled, slender leaves, grow from the base of the bunch

Single flower grows at the end of each branch

Found in plains, foothills, and mountains from 2,000 to 10,000 feet

Prefers sandy coarse textured soils



## Blue Bunch Wheatgrass

*4ci cone plug*                      \$2.00

Perennial Bunchgrass, 60 to 100 cm tall

Many stems form large clump

Widespread in dry open forests and grasslands at low elevations

# Flowers



## **Milk Weed (Showy)**

*3.5" pot*

*\$8.00*

Perennial, 40 to 120 cm tall, rhizomatous, soft greyish-hairy throughout

Pink to reddish-purple 5 petal flowers, fruits are hairy pods

Common at low elevations and dry climates.

Open areas, full sun



## **Red Columbine**

*3.5" pot*

*\$8.00*

Tap-rooted, perennial, up to 1 meter tall.

Irregular, red sepals and yellow petals, fruits are clusters of 5 erect capsules

Widespread and common at low to subalpine elevations in moist, open forests and meadows



## **Arrowleaf Balsam Root**

*10ci cone plug*

*\$4.00*

Perennial, 20 to 80 cm tall. Aromatic woody taproot and branches stem base

Bright yellow ray flowers and yellow disc flowers

Wide spread in mid to low elevations in hot arid climates

# Flowers



## **Yarrow**

*3.5" pot*

*\$8.00*

Aromatic perennial , 30 to 100 cm tall

Numerous, white to cream-colored flower heads

Thrives in poor soil

Dry to moist, well-drained, open sites, meadows,  
and rocky slopes

Open areas, full sun



## **Venus Penstemon**

*3.5" pot*

*\$8.00*

Perennial, 30 to 60 cm tall

Several stalked violet-purple  
flower clusters

Does best in well-drained soils  
Has excellent cold winter and  
drought tolerance

Common at low elevations

Full sun



## **Blanketflower**

*3.5" pot*

*\$8.00*

Tap root perennial, 30 to 90 cm tall

Low mound of light-green leaves which give rise  
large yellow daisy-like flowers with a brown eye

Bright yellow ray flowers and yellow disc flowers

Prefers well-drained soil and thrive with little  
moisture

Wide spread in mid to low elevations in hot arid  
climates

Full sun

# Flowers and Shrubs



## Rocky Mountain Iris (Blue Iris)

*3.5" pot*

*\$8.00*

Perennial, 20 to 60 cm tall

Flowers pale to deep blue, purple-lined

Common in moist meadows, especially in sagebrush and Ponderosa pine forests

Most drought-tolerant of our native irises

Full sun to part shade



## Blue Elder Berry


*1 gallon pot*

*\$10.00*

Deciduous shrub to small tree 2—4 meters tall

Small white to creamy flowers in flat top clusters. Fruits in clusters of juicy round powder blue edible berries.

Moist to mesic sites in valley bottoms, on mountain slopes, and water ways



## Big Sagebrush

*40ci cone plug*

*\$8.00*

Branching, greyish, evergreen, aromatic shrub, up to 2 m tall.

Small and yellow flowers

Wide spread and common at low to mid elevations in arid grasslands

Intolerant of alkaline soils

# Trees and Shrubs



## Oceanspray

*1 gallon pot*

*\$10.00*

Deciduous shrub, 3 to 6 m tall and wide

Flowers are white to cream with lilac-like drooping clusters

Dry to moist soil, found in open forests or disturbed areas

Drought tolerant

Fragrant



## Hardhack

*1 gallon pot*

*\$10.00*

Deciduous shrub, 1 to 2 m tall

Fragrant pink-rose flowers

Grows in moist areas in forest, bogs, streambanks, at low to mid elevations

Requires moist soil

Full sun to partial shade



## Douglas Fir

*Tall pot*

*\$12.00*

Large conifer, up to 70 m tall

Yellow-green leaves

Small reddish brown cones

Dry low elevation sites to moist montane sites

# Trees and Shrubs



**Ponderosa Pine**

*Tall pot* *\$12.00*

Conifer, 15 to 30 m tall, 1 to 1.5 m diameter trunk

Evergreen needles in bundles of 3.

Oval conical cones, 8 to 14 cm long

Draught tolerant

Found in open forests and dry valleys



**Quaking Aspen**

*1 gallon pot* *\$10.00*

Deciduous tree, up to 30 m tall

Smooth green-grey waxy bark

Green leaves turn golden yellow to orange in fall

Moist to dry soils, shade tolerant



**Red Osier Dogwood**

*Tall pot*

*\$10.00*

Deciduous shrub, 1 to 4 m tall

Green leaves turn reddish in autumn

Small white to greenish , dense clumps of flowers

Found in swamps, moist uplands, openings and clearings

# Trees



## Rocky Mountain Juniper

*Tall pot* *\$12.00*

Conifer, 10 to 20 m tall

Leaves long and needlelike, green or blue-green color

Cones are yellowish-brown and papery

Berries are waxy dark blue or bluish-purple

Grows in prairie hillsides, fields, pastures, woodlands,  
in rocky, sandy, or clay soils



## Garry Oak

*Tall pot* *\$12.00*

Deciduous tree, 15 to 35 m tall

Broad spreading, rounded crown, crooked branches, often  
shrubby when young

Dark green leaves turn brown, tinted gold or dull red in autumn

Drought tolerant

Produces acorns

Sun, likes dry soil in summer
